

**Hands-on Training in Network Meta-Analysis Methodology
(In collaboration with Knowledge Synthesis Canada)**

Summary: The remit of the training program will be to provide members of the Manitoba Research Community with advanced training in Network Meta-Analytic techniques (also known as 'Multiple Treatment Comparisons'). This will include gaining hands-on experience by participating in analyses, and educational seminar sessions on the history, conduct, reporting, and future research in this field.

Target audience: Clinicians, researchers, academics, policy-makers and anyone interested in gaining a better understanding of the core concepts, benefits and limitations of rapidly reviewing the literature. Prior knowledge and experience conducting traditional meta-analysis would be beneficial.
