The WRHA Project Management Office and Manitoba eHealth are collaborating to deliver The Canadian Health Outcomes for Better Information and Care (C-HOBIC) project. The project will collect information from existing databases in Home Care and Long Term Care (MDS-HC and MDS 2.0) to report on nurse sensitive indicators that have been proven to positively impact patient care outcomes. This national project, funded by Canada Health Infoway and led by the Canadian Nurses Association, with participation from Ontario, Saskatchewan and Manitoba, collects nursing related patient outcomes to provide information to clinicians so they can more effectively plan and evaluate care and provides data for managers and executives to use when examining the quality of care provided by their units and organizations.

The focus of the C-HOBIC project will be to develop and deliver new reports to clinical staff and management involved in care planning and interventions to defined outcomes. The new reports are anticipated to enhance understanding of the nursing-sensitive outcomes, the affect on resident / client care outcomes and the ability to adapt care plans to adjust to the assessment measures.
