Medication Reconciliation is one of six initiatives promoted by the CPSI (Canadian Patient Safety Institute), under the Safer Health Care Now! Project in Canada and the 100,000 Lives Project in the U.S. The purpose of this project is to implement a medication reconciliation process to minimize the number of healthcare system failures that result in unnecessary deaths or injuries related to medication errors. This will involve a practice review and the implementation of improvements on how the transfer of medication information is provided on key transition points such admission, transfer and discharge. This project will span the continuum of care involving all sectors i.e. Acute Care Hospitals, Long Term Care, and Community Services.
